BCLP ADVISES THE MOSAIC COMPANY IN STRATEGIC PARTNERSHIP WITH SOUND AGRICULTURE

SUMMARY

The international law firm BCLP advised The Mosaic Company in its strategic partnership with Sound Agriculture, to bring a revolutionary nutrient efficiency product to market to boost yields across major row crops and improve soil health. The companies will collaborate on the development and distribution of a proprietary mix of Sound's bio-inspired chemistry and key micronutrients.

The co-developed product is expected to launch in the United States by 2023, before rolling out to additional markets throughout the Americas, with a focus on Brazil, Argentina and Canada.
